

Eligibility Requirements

1. Both parties **must appear together in-person** at 625 Court Street, Room B-01, Woodland, CA at the time the license is to be issued.
2. Parties **must present valid photo identification** as proof of name and date of birth. Acceptable forms of I.D. are:
 - o Driver's License
 - o Passport
 - o Military I.D.
 - o Resident Alien Card
3. Parties **must be unmarried**. You may not be already married to each other or other individuals.
4. If either party was previously married, you must provide the exact date the previous marriage ended and how it ended (death, dissolution, divorce, or nullity). If the previous marriage ended by dissolution, divorce, or nullity **within the past 30 days**, you must present a copy of the final judgment issued by the court.
5. Parties living together as spouses who meet the required conditions may apply for a confidential marriage license.
6. You do not need to be a U.S. citizen or California resident to apply for a marriage license.

Under 18 Years of Age

Persons under the age of 18 must present notarized Parent or Guardian Consent Statement and a certified copy of the court order granting the minor permission to obtain a marriage license. Emancipated minors are not exempt from this requirement.
